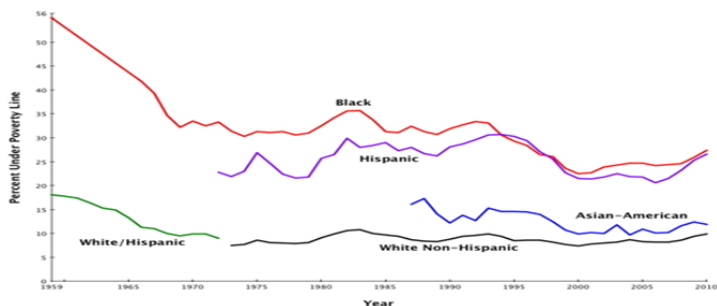
The Mess We're In
